At Fairfield students start their world of work journey developing their employability skills and then progressing into work based learning in the following areas: canteen, farm shop, market garden, Weavers pub, animal park, bakery, café, reception or dog grooming parlour. Our Careers team works with students to identify a work experience placement that meets their aspirations and future goals of paid or voluntary employment.



Students at Fairfield study for a BTEC qualification either in Hospitality and Tourism, Work Skills or Vocational Skills. Students at Fairfield have an Educational Health and Care Plan (EHCP). The college offers programmes for 16-24 year olds with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). We are Ofsted inspected and most recently in 2019 achieved good with room for becoming outstanding.

Our experienced Job Coach team will also support our students with any induction training that is required and break down tasks and job carve if needed. Our Job Coach team will regularly check in to see how things are going and support both you and the student.

Useful Information

As part of a work experience placement we usually need to take some photos of our students at work to use as evidence in their BTEC portfolio. We sometimes use photos to promote employer engagement via college social media and newsletters. Please let us know if you would prefer photos not to be used externally.

Prior to a placement starting we would need a copy of the organisations public liability certificate. This is the only legal requirement.

Our Job Coach team will carry out a risk assessment and complete a world of work agreement prior to the placement starting. We also welcome your own risk assessments and induction paperwork.
